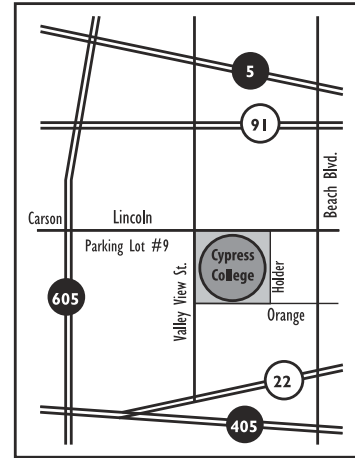
### Career Opportunities

- 12.7% increase in Police, Fire and Ambulance Dispatchers - a total increase of 11,716 new jobs;
- 13.2% increase in Occupational Health and Safety Specialists and Technicians - a total increase of 5,445 new jobs;
- 20.7% increase in Firefighters - a total increase of 58,454 new jobs;
- 22.4% increase in Detectives and Criminal Investigators - a total increase of 21,006 new jobs;

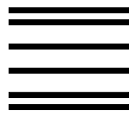
