MINIMUM SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS

- Enrolled in or will enroll at Cypress College in the fall 2013 semester with a minimum of 9 units
- Cypress College grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher
- Graduated from a high school with a minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher
- United States citizen
- Resident of the state of California
- Preference given but not required that the recipient be of Hawaiian, Japanese, or Pacific Islander Ancestry

GENERAL INFORMATION

Scholarship awards are generally \$250. All candidates with a legible e-mail address will be notified by e-mail by the middle of April, 2013. Those who have won scholarships will be invited to participate in the Cypress College scholarship ceremony which will be held in May 6, 2013. Most scholarship funds are held until fall enrollment is verified and after the fall drop-date has passed, usually the third week of the fall semester.

DIRECTIONS (please read carefully)

- Complete application. It is extremely important that the scholarship application is 100% complete and that the directions are followed to the letter. Failure to answer every question, in the exact manner required, will result in your application being disqualified. Additional sheets of paper will be necessary please be sure that they are attached. Also remember that your essay must be typed. Applications with handwritten essays will be disqualified.
- Answer ALL questions fully and legibly. Do NOT list your Social Security number in place of your student ID number. If you do not know your student ID number, check with the Admissions and Records office. If a question does not apply to you, such as "spouse's occupation" if you are single, answer the question with "not applicable". Do NOT leave any questions unanswered. If information is left off of your application, or if any portion of your application is illegible, your application will be disqualified. Sign and date the release on page five. If the release is not signed and dated, your application will be disqualified.
- The last question is separate from the other questions and will be evaluated separately on its own merits. Be sure to type essay for this question on a separate sheet of paper.
- It is strongly recommended, though not required, that you attach a letter of recommendation from an NOCCCD faculty or staff member. This letter cannot be from anyone who sits on the scholarship committee or from anyone associated with the Airline and Travel Careers Department, and must be from a faculty or staff member from North Orange County Community College District (Cypress College, Fullerton College, School of Continuing Education or NOCCCD District offices) or for high school students, your current high school counselor, faculty or administration member.
- Financial Aid Office: Submit application no later than 5 pm, Wednesday, February 28, 2013, to the FINANCIAL AID OFFICE. Faxes will not be accepted. Applications may be mailed, but postmarks are not proof of delivery. Applications must be stamped as accepted by the Financial Aid office prior to 5 pm, Wednesday, February 28, 2013 – no exceptions, regardless of the mailing date.
